“Zintoni amagama azo?” wabuza uSizwe, ejonga ebhotileni.

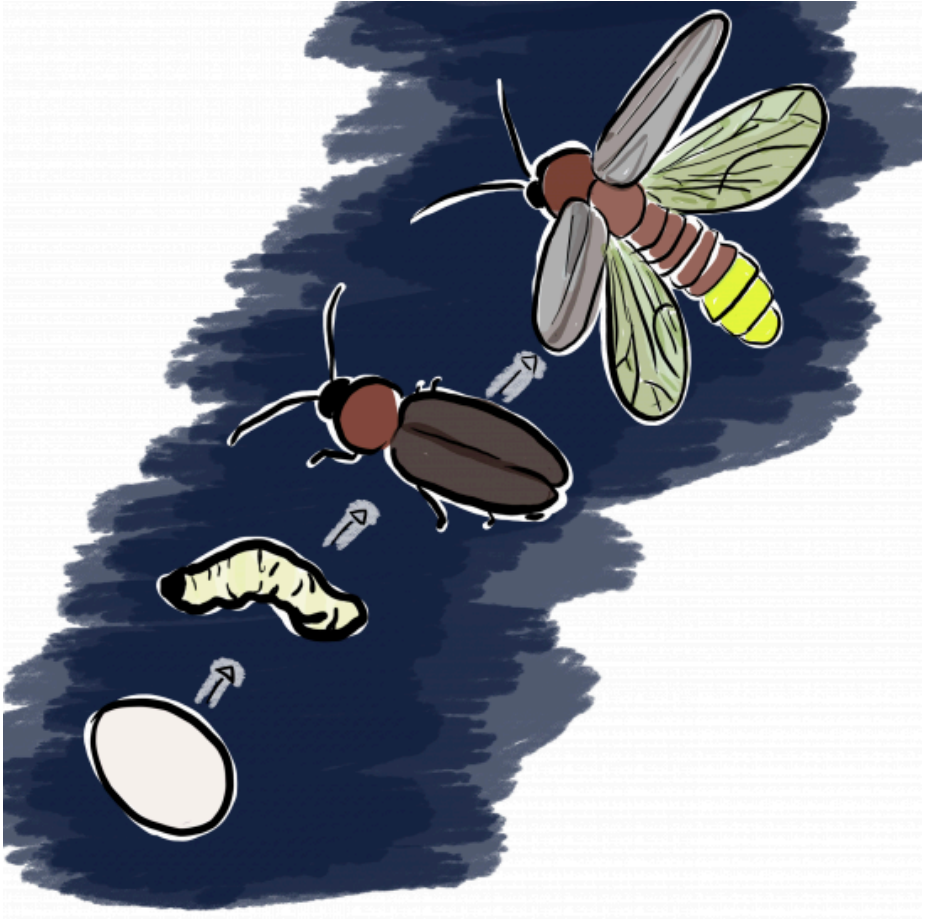
“Zikwenza njani okwaa kukhanya?” wabuza uTito.



“Esa sinambuzane yinkanyezi. Kwaye asiyompukane, nguqongqothwane,” watsho usisi kaTito omdala, uGcina.

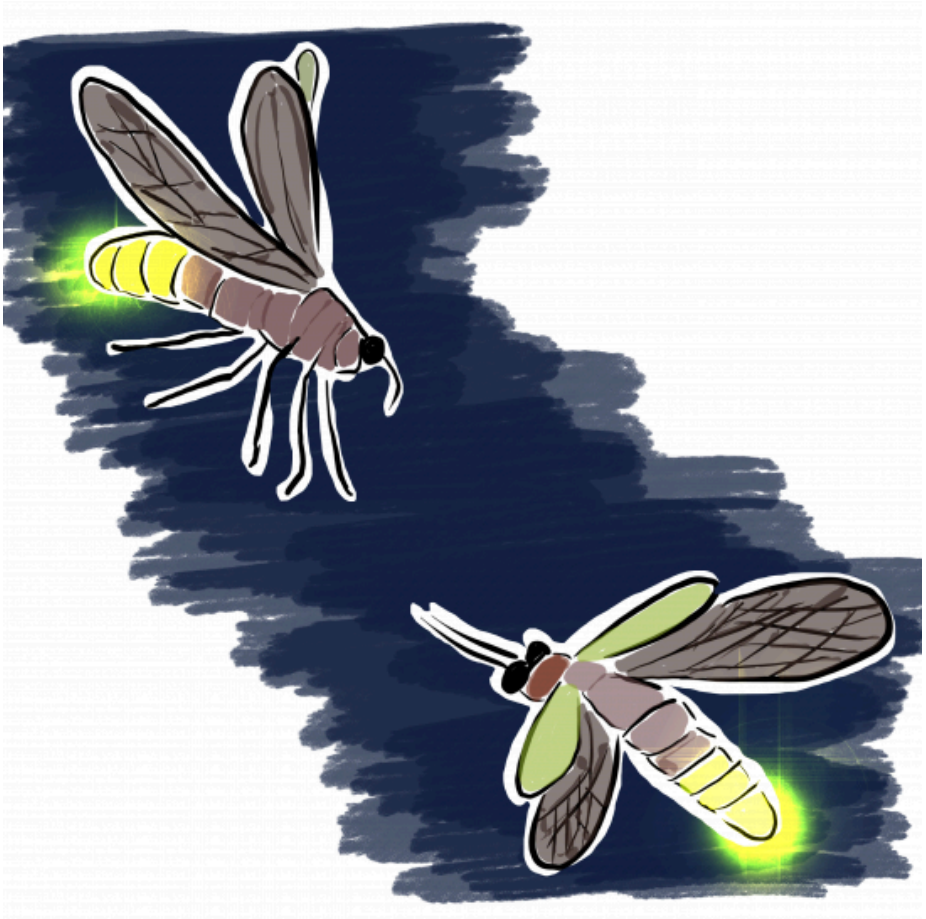
“Ukukhanya kuvela emzimbeni wesi sinambuzane,” watsho.
